

Instructions:

- 1. Charging the power bank:
- a. Using 2-in-1 charging cable, insert the USB A port into a certified USB AC adapter or USB port of a computer, insert the 2-in-1 tip (the side with pins upwards) into power bank micro input. Then charge begins.
- b. When Charging LED Indicator will flash BLUE, Once fully charged LED will be solid BLUF.
- 2. Charging mobile phones and other electronic devices:
- a. Connect the 2-in-1 cable to your mobile phone/device. If Android device, the tip with pins upwards; If iOS device, the tip without pins upwards. Connect the other end to the power bank. BLUE LED Indicator will illuminate when charging.
- b. Remove the USB cable from your mobile device when it is fully charged.
- * Note: In order to charge devices, use only the accessory cable or the cable included with your own device by the manufacturer.
