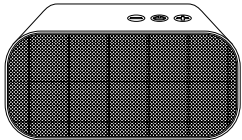


Stark Bluetooth Speaker

What's included:

- 1 x Stark Bluetooth Speaker
- 1 x USB to Micro-USB charging cable
- 1 x 3.5mm Aux Cable
- 1 x Instruction Manual

Tech Specifications

- Charging power supply: DC5V/500mA (Battery Indicator LED is red when charging. Turns off when fully charged).
- Low power warning: When voltage is lower than 3.4V, two beeps will sound and the battery indicator LED will flash blue.

Instructions:

- Charging the Speaker:**
 - Using a regulated USB adapter. Connect the provided Micro-USB to USB cable to a power source and to the Micro-USB port of the speaker. The LED indicator will glow RED when device is charging and will turn off when fully charged.
- Connecting the Speaker to Bluetooth:**
 - Turn the speaker "ON" by long pressing the **Mode** button, speaker will tone when on and ready to begin pairing.
 - Using a Bluetooth enabled device, search for "Stark" from the list of available pairs.
 - Once selected, the speaker will tone when successful paired.
- Using the Speaker:**
 - When receiving a phone call, the speaker will pause the current audio. Press the **Mode** button to answer the call, press this button again to end the call.
 - Short Press **⏮** : play/pause the audio
 - Short Press **⏭** : next track
 - Long Press **⏭** : volume increase
 - Short Press **⏮** : previous track
 - Long Press **⏮** : volume decrease
 - Long Press **⏻** : turn OFF the speaker

* Note: In order to charge device use only accessory cable (provided with device) or the cable provided with your own device by the manufacturer.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

- WARNING—When using this product, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

 - Device main unit contains an internal lithium-ion battery. Upon initial use or after a prolonged storage period, fully charge it once.
